Summary of Position

You will be responsible for managing, motivating and supporting your Performance Instructors to collaboratively deliver fun and exciting group Musical Theatre workshops and inspire the next generation.

You will ensure successful execution of all policies and procedures, liaising with parents, school representatives and Central Office where necessary. As well as leading performing sessions, staff will contribute to the high standard of physical, emotional, and social care offered by the Ultimate Activity Company. There will be a Camp Manager on-site to provide support on care and parent issues.
